

STEP 1 - INSTALL UPPER & LOWER CASSETTE MOUNTING BRACKETS

With mounting hardware provided install the upper and lower cassette mounting brackets. Brackets can be ceiling or wall mounted depending on the application. Image below shows ceiling mount only outside wall mounting can be observed by referring to the Curved Cassette Install Instructions.




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STEP 2 - INSTALL THE LOWER CASSETTE


Clip in the lower cassette into the installed bottom mounting brackets.





STEP 3 - INSTALL THE UPPER CASSETTE

Clip in the upper cassette into the installed top mounting brackets.






STEP 4 - PREPARING THE LIFT STRAPS

Carefully cut the tape off at the bottom of the upper cassette this will expose 12mm clear lift strap that is attached to the weight.




DO NOT REMOVE THE WEIGHT: The weight is designed to keep the spool under tension and should not be removed until the lift strap is ready to be inserted into the bottom bar.



STEP 5 – LOWER THE LIFT STRAPS

While each strap is dangling, activate the motor and carefully lower the lift straps as close to the lower cassette as possible. Both lift straps should lower at the same time.



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STEP 6 - INSERT THE LIFT STRAPS ONTO BOTTOM BAR


Starting at one end, while keeping the strap taut, carefully remove the weight and insert the lift strap into the bottom bar spline. The shade might have to be lifted by hand slightly to fit the spline in.





Positioning:

Ensure the lift strap is parallel to each side of the window frame. Once aligned, cut off any excess strap sticking out of the bottom bar.




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STEP 7 – ALIGNING THE LIFT STRAPS

Move the shade to its upper and lower limit while ensuring the lift strap wraps around the tube between each spool evenly without wandering left or right excessively.






If the strap wanders to much or does not look aligned while the shade was moving, <u>finely</u> adjust the strap left or right and repeat the movement to the upper and lower limit until the strap is properly aligned and the movement looks good.



STEP 8 - LEVEL THE BOTTOM BAR (THE TAPE METHOD)

If the bottom bar does not look level and is under a 3/16 off, the tape method can be applied. Bring the shade to the lower limit and apply clear tape to the side that needs to be raised up. The piece and amount of tape is determined by the amount of lift this side requires.





Tape Required:

Optically Clear Laminating Tape 1/2" Wide (Vinyl Plastic)


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STEP 9 - ATTACH THE BOTTOM BAR END CAPS


Finish the assembly by screwing in the bottom bar end caps on either side of the shade. The shade might need to be pulled out slightly to do this.

Do this gently without shifting the bottom bar left and right to much or the alignment will need to be re-adjusted.



STEP 10 - CHECK THE FINAL MOVEMENT

Ensure the final movement of the shade is ok and the straps are aligned properly. After any minor alignment tweaks, adjust motor limits to there finalized upper and lower limits.



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
